

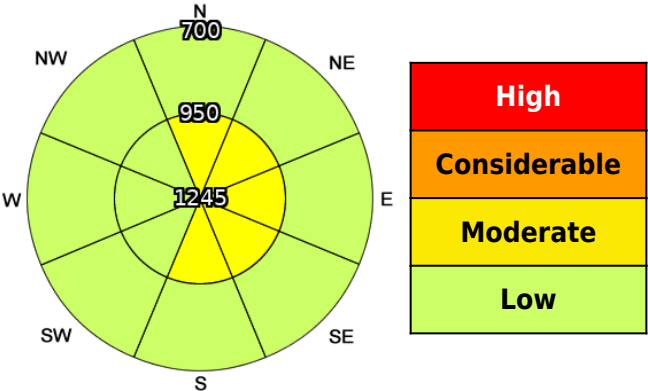

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 26/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will continue to consolidate in the cooler temperatures. New accumulations of windslab will develop on North through East to South aspects above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be snow showers overnight on strong South-Westerly winds. During the day the winds will gradually ease, veer to the North-West and snow showers will become lighter. The freezing level will lower to 900 metres.

Comments

Another very windy mild day today, snowpack has been rapidly thawing, cooler conditions expected over the weekend.
