

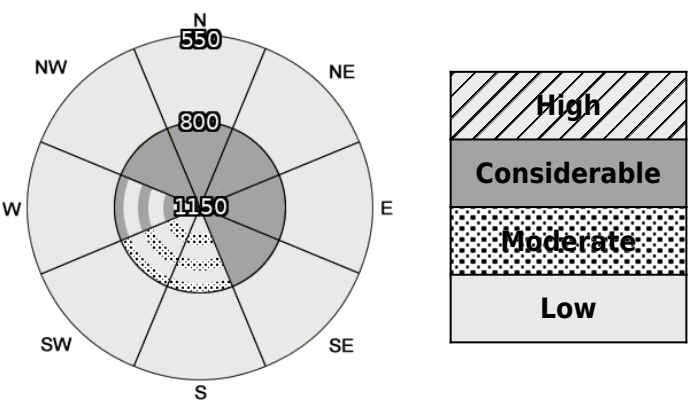

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 27/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New accumulations of snow are not expected to be significant and the older snowpack will continue to consolidate. Above 900 metres shallow windslab will form mainly in sheltered areas and in pockets on North-East through East to South aspects where, isolated localised instabilities may exist. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Scattered light snow showers above 600 metres with variable winds. The winds will be North-West becoming West then North through the period. The freezing level will be around 750 to 900 metres.

Comments

Patchy precipitation through the period, overnight the winds could be quite strong but should ease around mid morning. There could be a slight frost in the glens at dawn.
