


Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 28/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting will continue overnight depositing additional windslab on South-East to South aspects above 900 metres. Fluctuating temperatures will bring some marginal consolidation to pre-existing windslab on East to South aspects but residual instability will persist in localised accumulations above 1000 metres. Good stability is expected in all recently scoured locations. Considerable hazard of avalanche.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry throughout with moderate North winds becoming light during the day. Remaining relatively cold with an overnight frost possible.
