

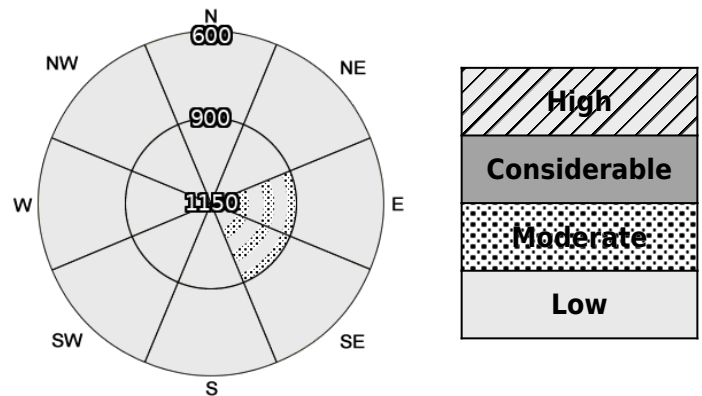
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 01/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The areas of moderately bonded wind slab are confined to high, steep, and convex terrain above 900 metres on East and South-East aspects. The rain will destroy the new surface hoar. Sun effect on South aspects may produce some surface sluffing, no deep releases will occur. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Summit temperatures will once again go above freezing. There is a risk of some patchy rain with light winds backing from North-West to South-West.

Comments

A slight warming spell but should not see appreciable snow loss.
