



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A little soft, thin drifted snow is possible on some steep Southerly aspects but quantities are expected to be very small. Colder temperatures will make surface layers of the older snowpack more tightly bonded and stable in all locations and at all levels. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Colder with a few very light snow flurries possible overnight. Winds will be light to moderate North or North Westerly.

Comments

Still a lot of good sport to be had in the Inner Corrie. Most low grade gullies in fine fettle and will benefit from the freeze up. South and Centre Post both OK but offer above grade challenges.
