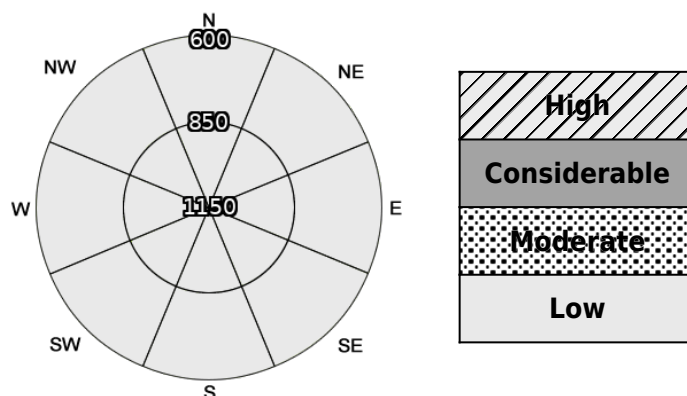


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 06/03/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The isothermic snowpack will remain generally stable. Lower overnight temperatures will form a surface crust. During the day warmer temperatures will again soften the top layers leading to isolated areas of surface instability, especially on aspects exposed to direct sunlight. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Little will change for the rest of the weekend as a ridge of high pressure maintains the current dry and settled conditions. The freezing level overnight will be around 800 metres with maximum summit temperatures reaching plus 3 degrees during Sunday. Winds will be light and from the South-West.

Comments

Surface instabilities and possible glide crack activity. SPF 30 recommended.
