

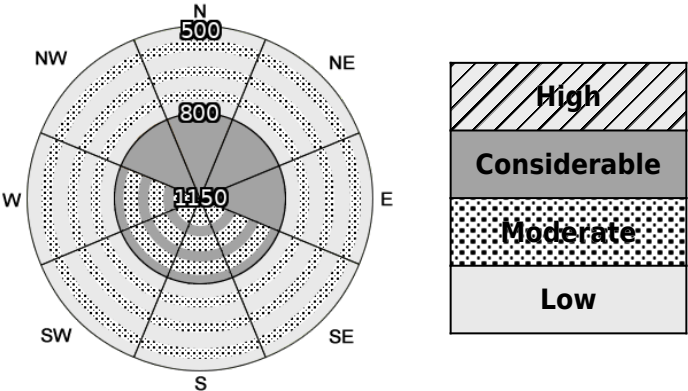

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 06/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

During the day the moist snowpack will start to re-freeze above 900 metres, though on slopes exposed to the effects of the sun there will be surface softening. Stability will generally be good on all aspects and at all levels. Any remaining cornices exposed to the sun will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Throughout the forecast period it is expected to remain dry with light South-Westerly winds. The freezing level is expected to be just above the summits overnight, dropping to 900 metres during the day.
