

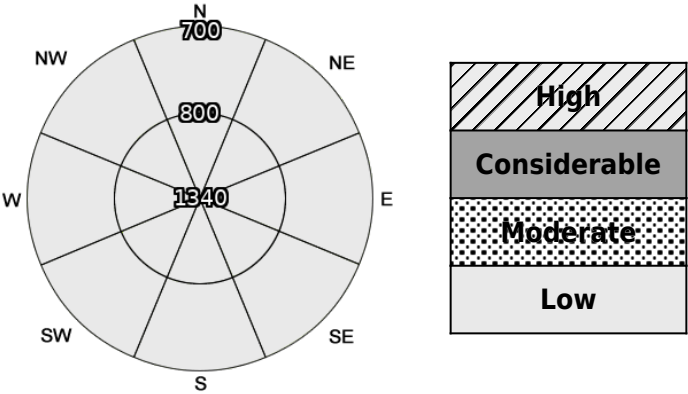

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 07/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Above 1100 metres the snowpack surface will be frozen and firm. Below this level and on slopes exposed to the effects of the sun the surface will soften. Stability will generally be good on all aspects and at all levels. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to remain dry throughout the forecast period with moderate South-Westerly winds becoming strong Westerly. The freezing level is expected to be at 1200 metres overnight falling to 1100 metres during the day.
