Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snow deposits will form weakly bonded windslab on sheltered North to Easterly aspects mainly above 800 metres where avalanches are likely, accumulations will form on other aspects due to cross loading. Gully exits, flanks and corrie rims will be particularly affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and during the day winds will be very strong South-Westerly with snow fall, becoming extensive in the daytime. Freezing level 800 metres lowering to 500 .
