

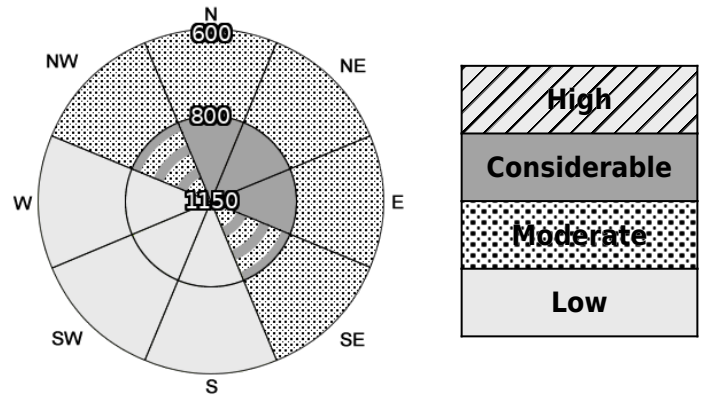
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 08/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of weakly bonded windslab will develop on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Cross loading will affect other areas particularly around gully heads and crag aprons. Elsewhere the snowpack will remain well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry night will be followed by snowfall on strong South-West winds. The freezing level will lower from 1000 metres to 500 metres on Tuesday.
