

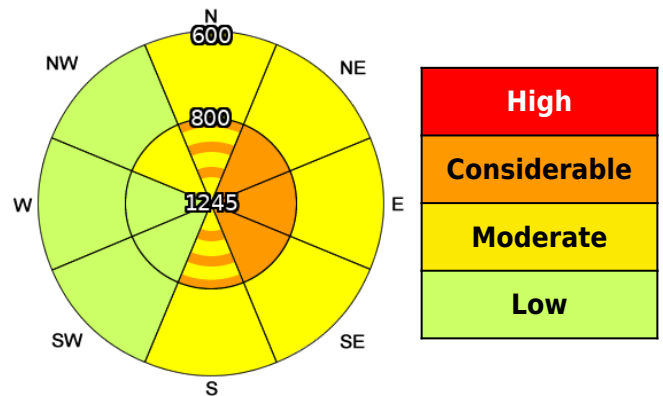
## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 09/03/2011

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of poorly bonded windslab will develop on mainly North-East to South-Easterly aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely, other aspects will also be affected due to cross loading, gully flanks, exits and other wind sheltered locations especially. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and during the day very strong Westerly winds will continue. The freezing level will be at 500 metres lowering to 300 metres and snow showers will be frequent, easing in the day but resuming later to all levels.

#### Comments

Freezing level mainly above tops today, but lowering tonight and wed with snow. Winter conditions and snow for rest of week.
