

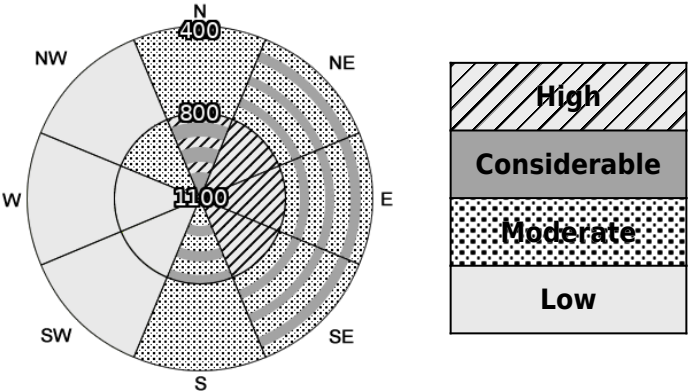

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 09/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh accumulations of unstable windslab will be deposited in sheltered gullies, hollows and on slopes with mainly North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches will occur. Other aspects will also be affected due cross-loading. Fresh cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Very strong Westerly winds are expected throughout the forecast period with frequent snow showers and the freezing level lowering from 500 metres to 300 metres.

Comments

Still condition snow depths of 15cm are expected which will drift significantly in the very strong Westerly winds.
