



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weakly bonded windslab will continue to be deposited on mainly North through East to Southerly aspects above 700 metres where avalanches will occur. Accumulations will also form in sheltered locations on other aspects due to cross loading. Cornices will continue to build and will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be Westerly remaining very strong. Heavy snow showers overnight with more prolonged snowfall from midday. Freezing level 600m overnight dropping to 300m in the day.

Comments

A very stormy day with poor visibility. Lots of spindrift and blown snow.
