

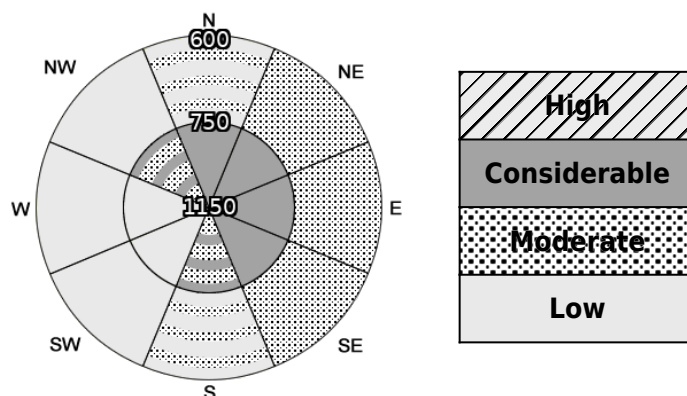

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 11/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Avalanches are likely above 750 metres on mainly North-East to South-East aspects. Winds will continue to move snow into these aspects on steep lee terrain and additionally cross load onto other slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Further snow showers, easing overnight, are forecast with winds moderating and backing from West to South West. Freezing level will be around 450 metres.

Comments

Difficult travel conditions during strong winds and poor visibility, somewhat brighter in the afternoon. Felt some very unstable snow underfoot on low angle terrain.
