

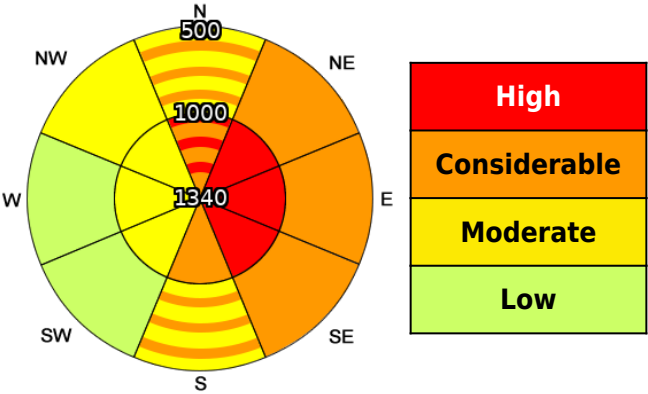

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 11/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poorly bonded windslab will be present in sheltered gullies, hollows and on slopes with mainly North through East to South-East aspects above 1000 metres where avalanches will occur. Unstable windslab will also be present in sheltered areas at lower levels and on other aspects due to cross-loading. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Frequent snow showers are expected throughout the forecast period, less frequent during the day. Winds very strong Westerly overnight, then backing South-Westerly and easing. Freezing level 600 metres then 450 metres during the day.

Comments

Avalanche debris noted on North-East and East aspects. Showers contained lots of graupel.
