Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The weak bonds in the recent snow will persist with further re-distribution due to the wind direction change. Avalanches are likely on all aspects above 800 metres, particularly on steep convex terrain, corrie rims and below cornices. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

Forecast Weather Influences

There will be a drying trend overnight with further snow showers later on Saturday. The winds will shift and lighten veering from North-West to North-East. The freezing level will remain between 300-500 metres.
