

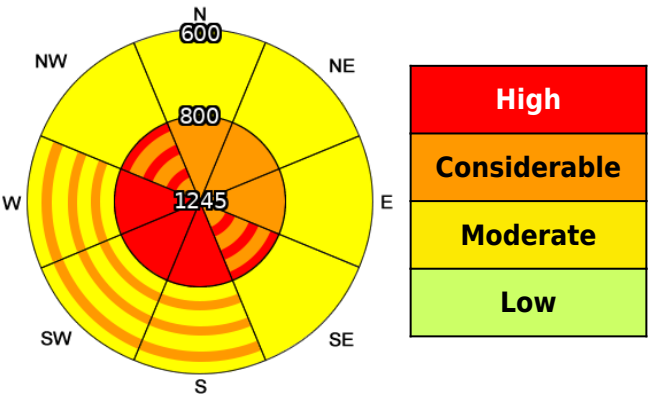

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 12/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

As the snowfall arrives new accumulations of windslab will develop and avalanches will occur on Southerly to Westerly aspects above 800 metres. Due to existing windslab deposits and cross loading instabilities will also affect North-West through North to South-East aspects above this altitude. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry overnight. During Saturday afternoon significant snowfall is expected to arrive. Light to moderate North-Westerly winds will veer and strengthen to North-Easterly with a freezing level around 300 metres.

Comments

Instabilities will be most prominent as the new snowfall arrives. Significant quantities expected especially during Saturday night.
