

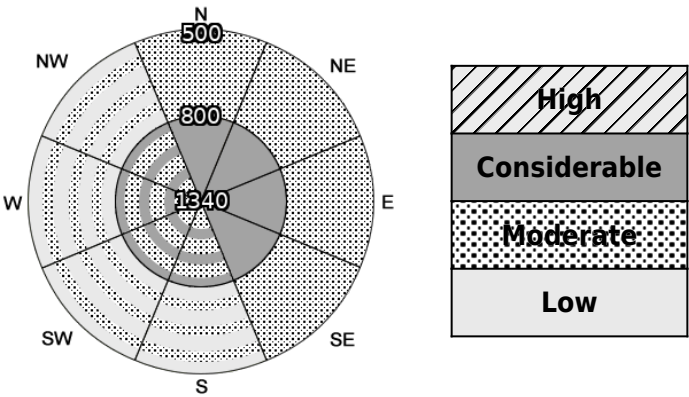

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 12/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Significant accumulations of moderate to weakly bonded windslab will remain on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. During the afternoon, strengthening winds and new snow will begin to deposit poorly bonded windslab on most other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry overnight and through the morning. A band of snow is expected to reach the area during the late afternoon. North-Easterly winds will strengthen through the day. The freezing level will be around 300 metres.

Comments

Soft snow and breakable crust making walking hard going above about 750 metres.
