

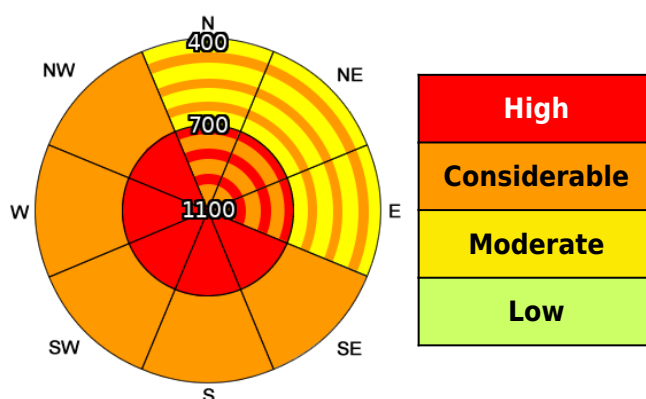

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 13/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

As the snowfall arrives new accumulations of windslab will develop and avalanches will occur on mainly South-East through South to North-West aspects above 700 metres. Due to existing windslab deposits and cross loading instabilities will also affect North to East aspects above this altitude. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

The wind will veer to the North-East increasing to very strong. There will be continuous, heavy snowfall over the next 24 hours giving significant accumulations of new snow. The freezing level will be at 450 metres.
