

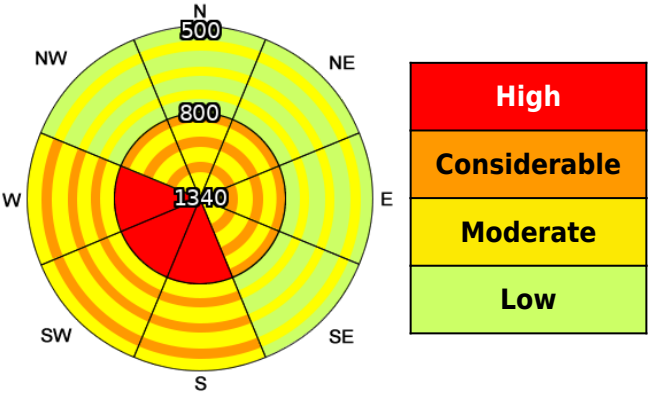

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 13/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh areas of unstable windslab will form in areas sheltered from the strong North-East winds. Greatest accumulations will be on South, South-West and West aspects above 800 metres. Avalanches will occur in these locations. On other aspects, some residual instabilities will remain and fresh instabilities will develop due to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be High. Slopes exposed to the wind will be scoured and stable.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be heavy snow above 400 metres with strong North-East winds. The freezing level will be at around 450 metres.
