

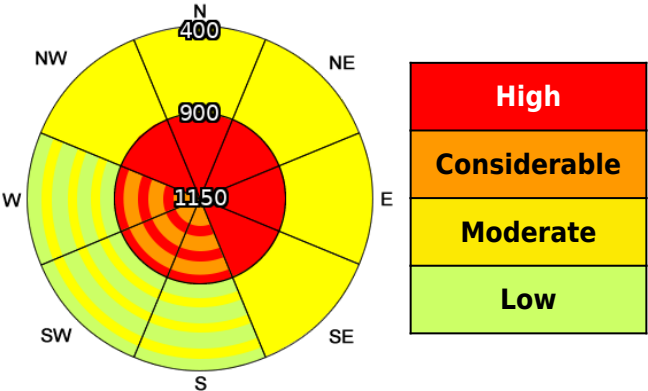

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 13/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large quantites of poorly bonded windslab will be deposited on South to West aspects above 700 metres where avalanches will occur; however due to cross loading and deposition that occurred earlier in the week, areas of unstable windslab are expected on most aspects above this level, especially in sheltered locations. Fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy snow will fall overnight and through the day. Strong winds will be from the North-East, and the freezing level will be around 450 metres.

Comments

Large amounts of fresh snow expected to make travel very hard going over the next few days.
