


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE HIGH

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 13/03/2011

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Avalanches will occur mainly on steep Southerly through West to North-West facing slopes above 600 metres. Cross loading and instabilities will affect most other aspects. Cornices will continue to develop and be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be High.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

There will be continuous heavy snowfall throughout the forecast period. The winds will be strong and from the North-East. The freezing level will rise for a time to 900 metres overnight then lower to 450 metres during the day.

#### Comments

Blizzard conditions and storm force winds expected over the next 24 hours.
