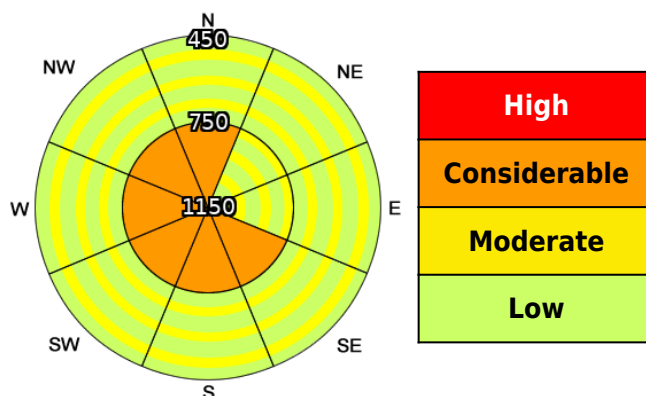

Some re-distribution of snow will occur and avalanches are likely due to additional storm snow accumulations as well as fluctuating freezing levels on mainly South-East through West to Northerly aspects above 750 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The weather forecast and situation are complex. Freezing levels will fluctuate but will be around 600- 450 metres. Winds will be Easterly overnight then South -Easterly and variable in the day. Moderate snowfalls are forecast with sleet at times dependent on elevation.

Comments

Avalanche conditions are tricky just now. The next 24 hours has a wide variety of changeable conditions; winds, snow/sleet amounts and freezing levels.
