

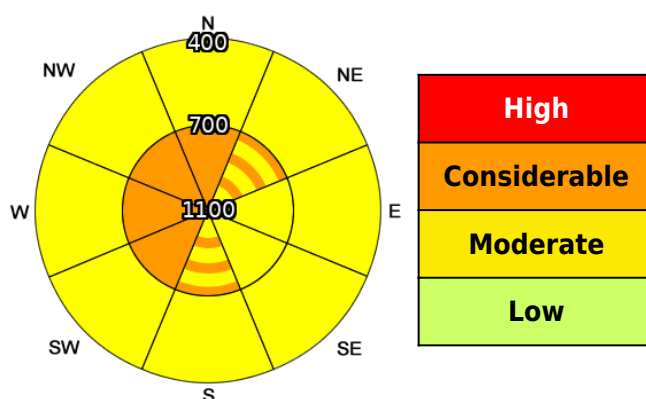

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 15/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New poorly stabilised windslab will develop on all South-West through West to North aspects above 700m where avalanches are likely. Localised accumulations of weak windslab will also be cross loaded in to some selected steep South and North East facing slopes and gullies. New, soft weak cornices may develop over the above aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry overnight then prolonged snow showers from late morning onwards. Remaining generally cold with moderate Easterly, later South-Easterly winds.

Comments

Trailbreaking pretty taxing, even on skis. Forecasted wind speeds at a critical threshold, more drifting likely if higher. Complicated weather forecast, check for updates.
