

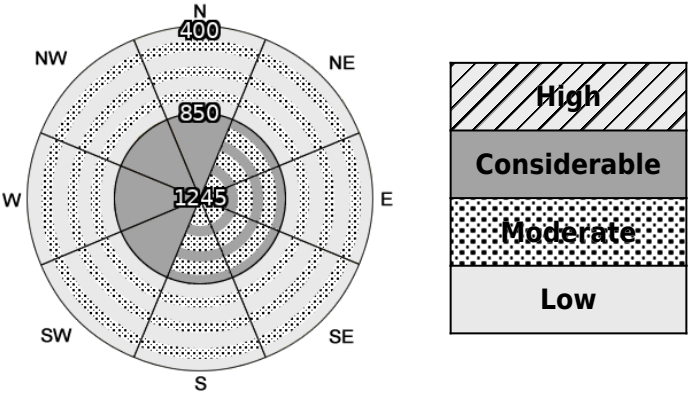

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The fluctuating freezing levels will help improve snowpack stability. Below 850 metres the snowpack on all aspects will generally be stable. However, instabilities will remain in the windslab deposits on mainly South-West through West to Northerly aspects above 850 metres, other aspects will have localised instabilities with steep slopes, and convex terrain being most affected. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the freezing level will rise to 1000 then become 600 metres in the day gradually rising again to 900 metres. Light snow or sleet overnight becoming dry in the day. Winds remain moderate South-Easterly.
