

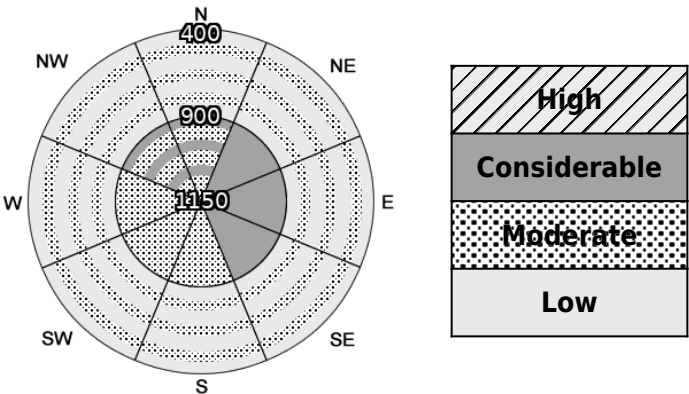

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 19/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

General snowpack stability should improve in many areas with the drier and less windy conditions. Moderate to poorly bonded windslab will remain in the most sheltered summit gullies and on steep slopes with a North through East to South East aspect mainly above 900 metres. Deep soft snow will exist on other aspects and alltitudes where bonding will be moderate on steeper ground . The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be fresh South-Westerly overnight backing Southerly on Saturday. The freezing level will be 900 metres. There will be isolated snow showers during the day.

Comments

Less windy and mainly dry with only isolated showers expected. Excellent cover of deep snow in many areas. Cornices will remain suspect.
