

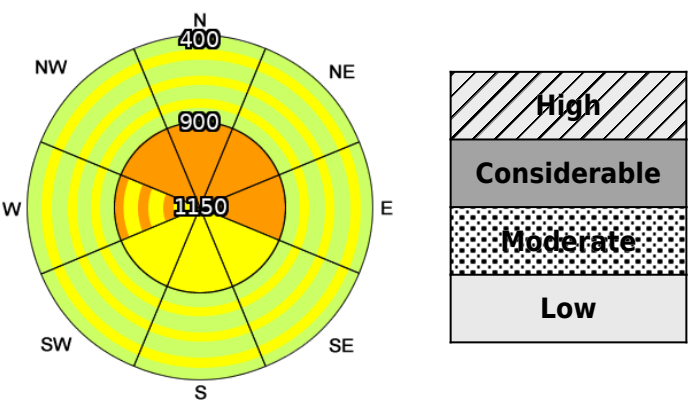

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 20/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Wet snow instabilities will exist on steeper slopes of many aspects. Particularly affected will be sheltered summit gullies, corniced areas and steep scarp slopes of a North-West through North to Easterly aspect mainly above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light rain will affect the area overnight and on Sunday as the freezing level rises to around 2000 metres. Winds will be from the South-West, initially fresh becoming strong later.

Comments

A slow gentle thaw is expected with light rain. Cornice collapse and rockfall hazard will exist.
