


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 20/03/2011

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will become moist at all levels. Instabilities will be present in the recently deposited windslab, mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Instabilities will also be present on steep slopes on all other aspects. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Light rain at all levels is expected to spread into the area overnight and continue during the day, with the freezing level rising during the day to 2000 metres. The winds are expected to be moderate South-Westerly strengthening to strong.

#### Comments

Off a beaten trail walking is hard work in the deep snow.
