

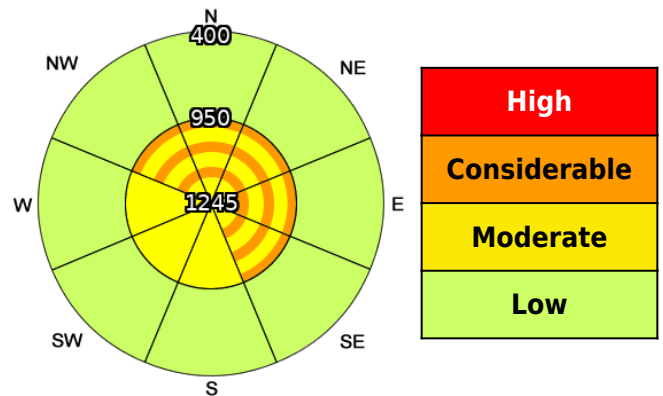

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate on all aspects and altitudes. Most steep and convex terrain will be subject to instabilities particularly on North-West through North and East to South-East aspects above 950 metres. Cornices will be weak and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry, mild conditions will continue with strong Westerly winds. The freezing level will be around 3000 metres.
