

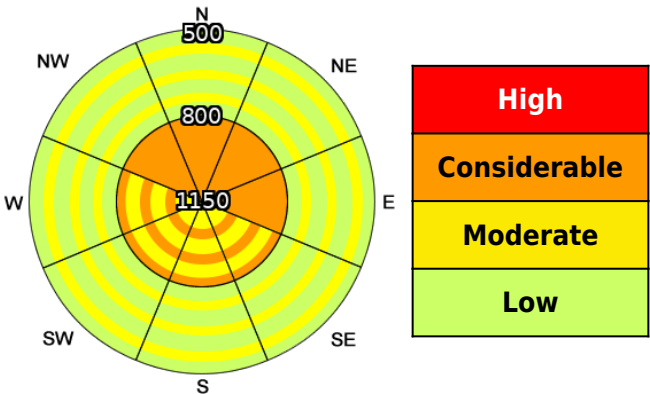
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 21/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Wet snow instabilities will exist on steeper slopes of many aspects. Particularly affected will be sheltered summit gullies, corniced areas and steep scarp slopes with a North-West through North to Easterly aspect mainly above 800 metres where Avalanches are likely. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be very mild with light rain throughout the period. Winds will be Westerly becoming gale force on Monday. Summit temperatures of around +7 degrees C are expected..

Comments

Mild and damp outlook. Hazard of cornice collapse and rockfall will exist throughout period.
