

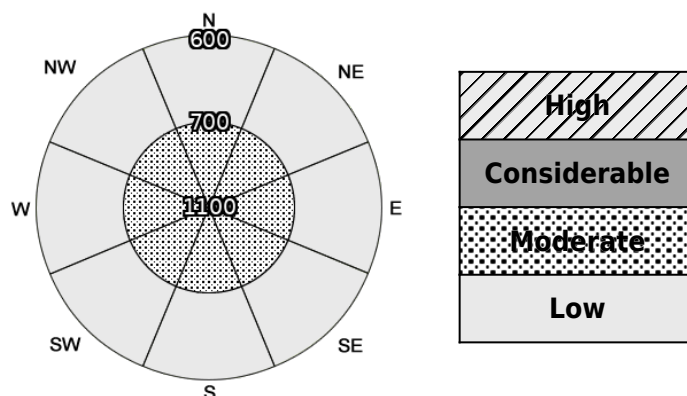

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 22/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Generally dry and somewhat cooler conditions will assist in snowpack consolidation at all levels. Localised deposits less well stabilised, wet snow will persist mainly on North-East through East to South East aspects above 950m. Cornices will continue to weaken and will be prone to spontaneous collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Warm overnight then cooler with freezing level falling to just above summits. Some sleety showers possible. Winds will be very strong South Westerly, moderating later and becoming Westerly.
