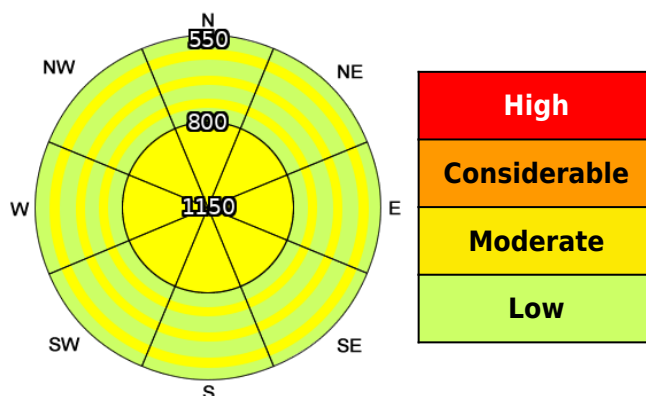


**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE****Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 22/03/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Snow loss will continue at all elevations with potential for the deeper snowpack gliding and cracking on steep ground. Surface snow instability will persist on all steep aspects above 800 metres. In some places the areas of weakly bonded moist loose snow will be quite deep. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Winds will ease a bit veering from South-West to West. Temperatures will cool slightly with freezing level still well above the tops. There will be light patchy rain from around mid-day.

**Comments**

Warm wind is rapidly eroding snowpack. Care required in areas of steep ground with loose moist snow instability. Areas of glide activity may start to move.
