

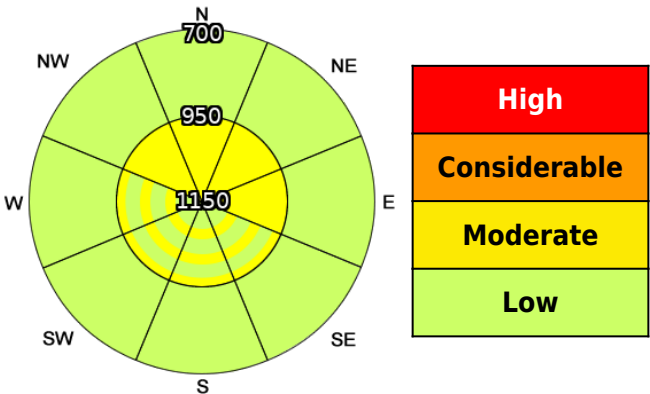

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 23/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain soft and moist at all levels, general stability will be good on all but the very steepest of slopes. These areas will be mainly in sheltered gully exits, corniced areas and steeper North-West through North to East facing slopes above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain very mild with light rain or drizzle at times on Wednesday, winds will be from the West fresh overnight becoming strong by morning.

Comments

Remaining mild with summit temperatures of +2 degrees C on Wednesday. Cornice collapse and rockfall will remain a hazard.
