

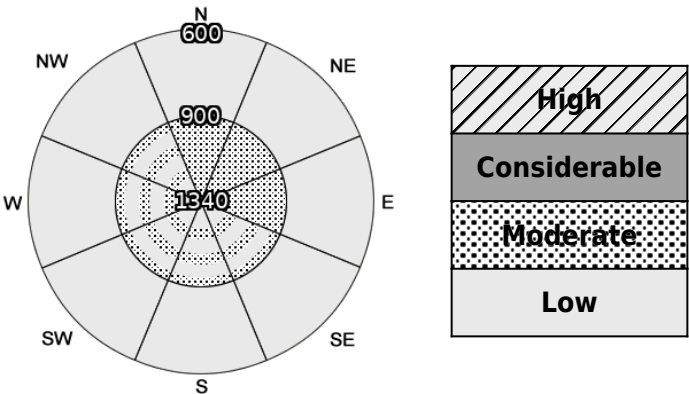

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 23/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw at all levels. Instabilities will remain on steep slopes and gullies, mainly above 900 metres. Elsewhere the snowpack will be generally stable. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level is expected to be well above the summits throughout the forecast period; dry overnight with light rain at all levels during the day. Winds are expected to be moderate becoming strong Westerly.

Comments

Rockfall will also be a hazard in the thawing conditions.
