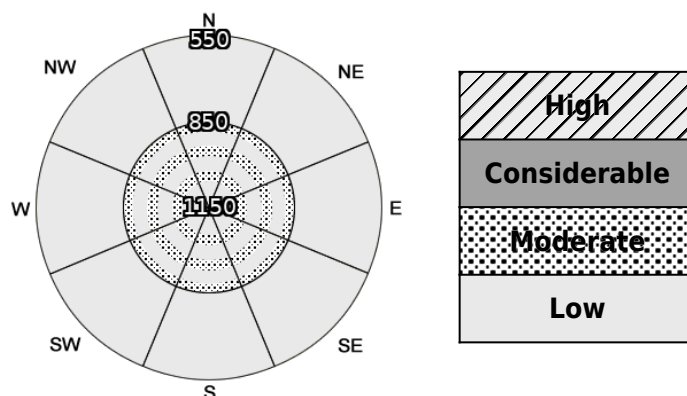


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 24/03/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

There will be little change in stability and hazard of the past few days. There will be loose surface snow instability on very steep ground above 850 metres on all aspects. Also the potential for ground release increases with melt on select smooth slabby terrain. Areas of deep unconsolidated snow exist around rock outcrops and irregular ground. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level will be slightly lower but still above the tops. It will be a dry day with light West-North-West winds.
