



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 26/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will re-freeze and generally be well bonded and stable on all aspects and at all levels. Some new snow accumulations will form soft windslab in isolated hollows and steep wind sheltered locations on mainly South through West to North aspects mainly above 900 metres, amounts though should be small and avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Cooler conditions are expected with a freezing level of 600 metres overnight and during the day. Winds will be light North-East veering South-Easterly in the day. Some light snowfall will occur overnight.
