

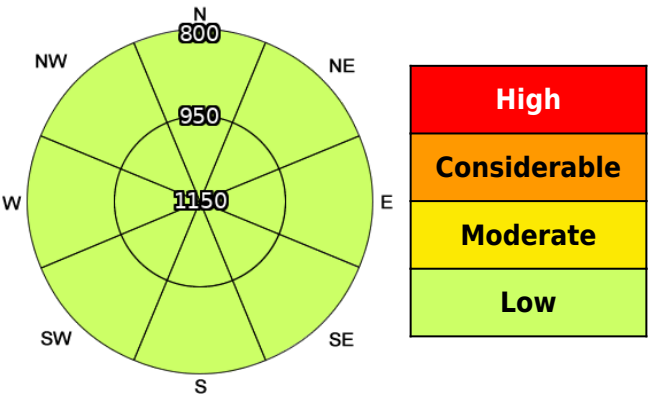

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 26/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will generally remain stable with the possibility of a firm surface developing overnight on the higher slopes. Solar warming through the day will soften affected slopes giving some minor instabilities on the steepest areas, cornices will however remain prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The dry and settled conditions will continue. It will become colder with freezing levels around 900 metres.

Comments

Snow surface may well be firm possibly icy where unaffected by solar warming. Cornice collapse and loose rock will remain a hazard.
