

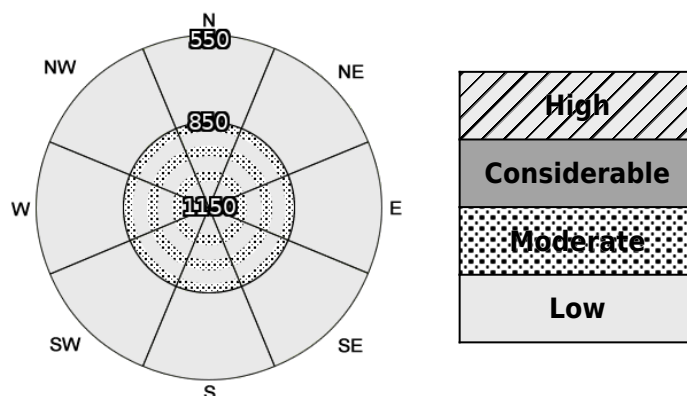

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 26/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The trace amount of snow forecast will not significantly alter the stability of the snow pack, in the cooling temperatures it will bond reasonably well to the old surface, and the deeper snowpack will strengthen. Isolated areas of instability will exist on all aspects of very steep ground mainly above 850 metres. Some of the near critical state cornices will collapse with additional load or undercutting. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing level will lower to 600 metres with light North-East winds veering to South-East during the day. There will be a trace of new snow.

Comments

Cooling trend will preserve winter conditions a bit.
