

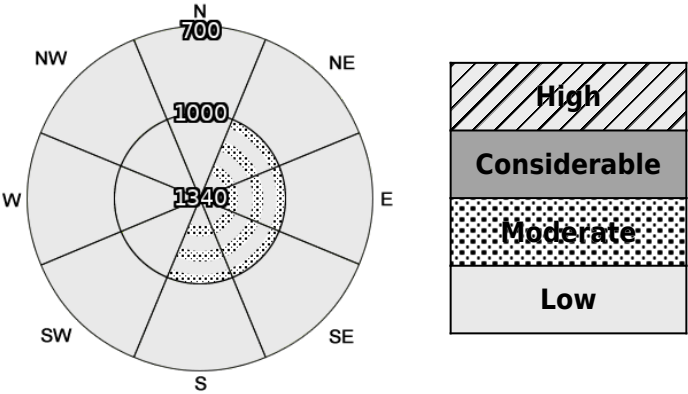

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 28/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A few small and generally avoidable patches of windslab will form at the tops of gullies and coire rims with North-East through East to South aspects above 1000 metres. Elsewhere stability will be good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A few light snow showers are expected overnight and through the day. The freezing level will rise from 900 metres to 1100 metres. North-Westerly winds will back to the West.

Comments

Rock and ice fall has been occurring recently on Ben Nevis. This is likely to remain a hazard until there is a good freeze.
