



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 29/03/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be good stability in most locations. Any build up of new windslab will be largely small isolated pockets of weakly bonded accumulations on mainly North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. As temperatures rise later in the day remaining cornices will become less stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and settled overnight with temperatures below freezing. Dry in the morning with intermittent light snow later in the day. Light Westerly winds backing South-East later. Midday summit temperatures close to freezing but increasing later in the day.

Comments

Some significant cornices remain on Lochnagar.
