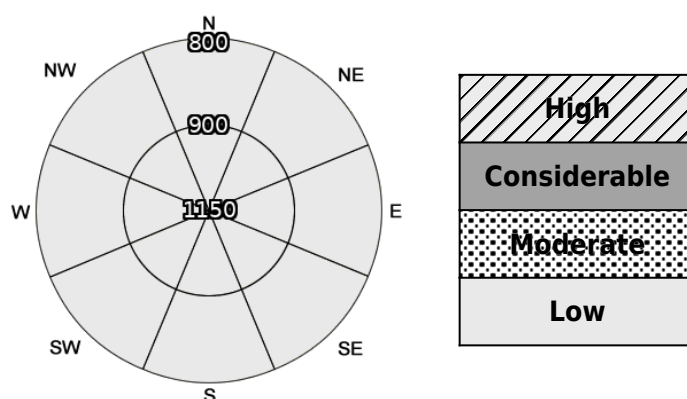


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 01/04/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will continue to thaw, some localised surface wet snow instabilities will exist on the steepest slopes on all aspects mainly above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The mild, wet conditions will continue to affect the area with heavy rain and storm force South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will remain well above the summits.

Comments

Storm force winds are forecast with gusts up to 95 mph. With the combination of heavy rain and snow melt, rivers and burns will quickly become swollen!
