

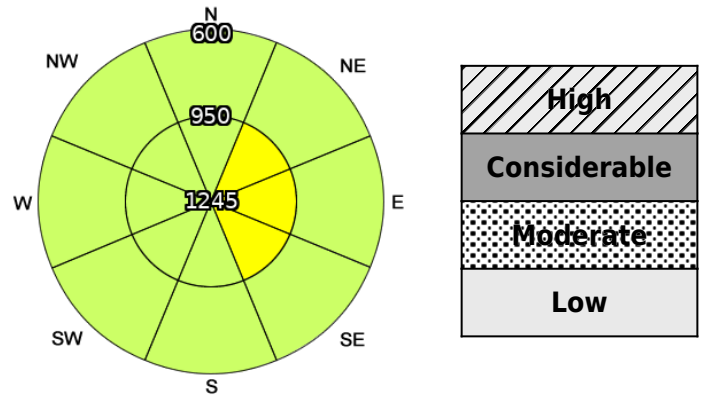

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will become more firm above 900 metres as it begins to re-freeze. In general the snowpack will remain well bonded and stable on all aspects and altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry with Strong South-Westerly winds and the freezing level will lower from 1000 to 900 metres.
