

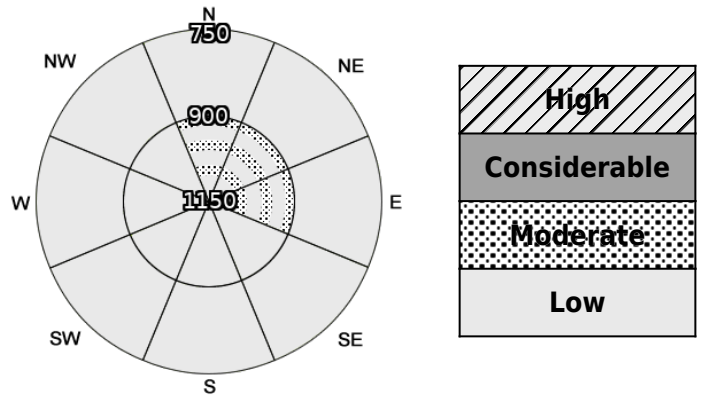

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New deposits of windslab will form in sheltered locations with the greatest accumulations on North to East aspects above 900 metres. These new deposits are expected to be localised and generally shallow, however where significant accumulations exist they will be moderately bonded on steep slopes. On other aspects the snowpack will be generally well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers above 750 metres with strong South-Westerly winds. The freezing level is expected to be at 900 metres.

Comments

Winter is returning for a short period with strong South-Westerly winds.
