



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 04/04/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised accumulations of moderately bonded windslab will develop on North to East aspects above 900 metres. On these aspects as the freezing level rises surface instabilities will develop particularly in areas of steep terrain. Elsewhere the snow pack will remain well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry night will be followed by snow showers during the day on strong South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will rise from 900 to 1200 metres.

Comments

Looks like the recent warm, wet weather was too much for "The Great Slab" in Lochain as a large section has avalanched.
