

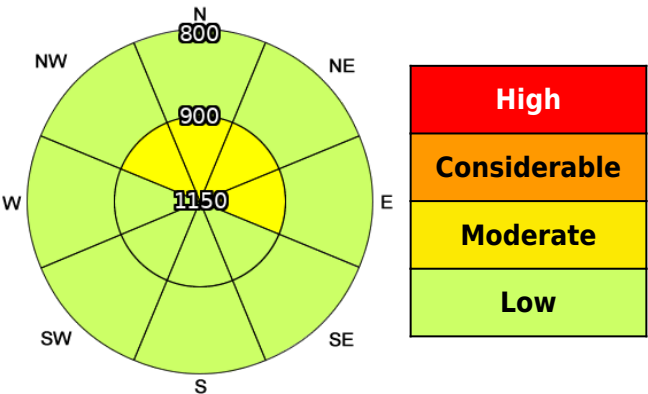
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 05/04/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

As the freezing level rises to above the summits wet snow instabilities will increase especially on steeper slopes where newer windslab has formed. The greatest hazard will be on North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Cornices will also be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, heavy rain at most levels with strong South-Westerly winds these conditions will give way to more showery rain and decreasing South-Westerly winds during the day. The freezing level will fluctuate from 2000 to 2500 metres

Comments

No new snow is expected but as freezing levels fluctuate this may produce some sleet over the summits. Remaining quite windy.
