

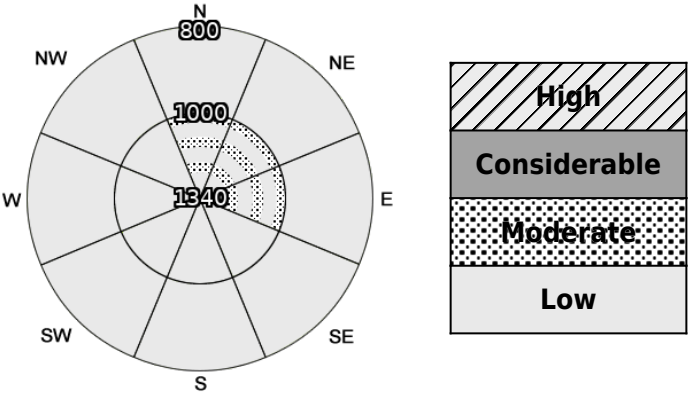

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 06/04/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate in the mild wet conditions in most areas, however some instabilities will be present on mainly steep North to East aspects above 1000 metres. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Very mild and wet conditions are expected. The freezing level will be around 3000 metres, and heavy rain with moderate to strong, South-Westerly winds expected.

Comments

A very mild and wet day expected on Wednesday. Rock and ice fall will be a hazard.
