

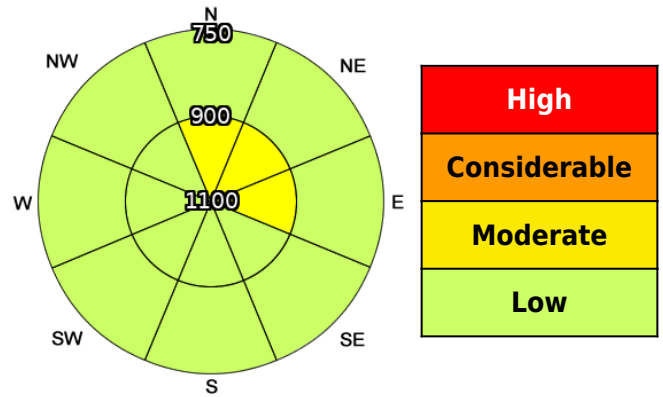
## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 06/04/2011

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw at all levels. Wet snow instabilities will persist on steep slopes mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres. The possibility of full depth avalanche remains on a few very steep North to East aspects. Elsewhere the snowpack will be generally stable. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain well above the summits and heavy rain is expected at all levels throughout the forecast period. Winds are expected to be strong South-Westerly and strengthening.

#### Comments

Cornices remain above the NW side of the Inner Coire and around some other coires. Hazard exists from cornice collapse, rock and ice fall.
