

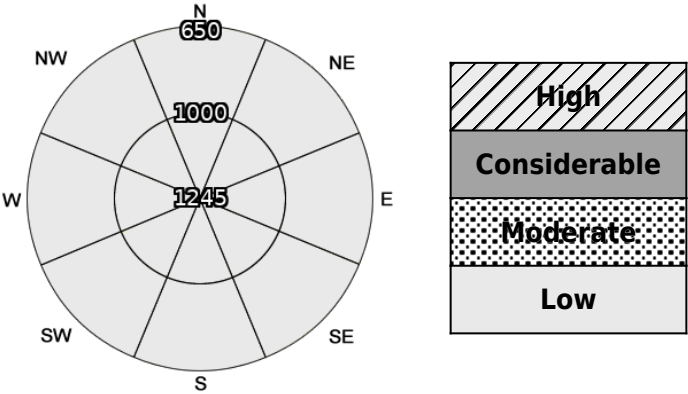

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snowfall is expected to be light and will leave isolated deposits of windslab on North-East to South-East aspects above 1000 metres. In general the snowpack will remain well bonded and stable at all altitudes and aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain will turn to snow briefly before clearing to leave a dry day. The winds will be strong West to North-Westerly. The freezing level will fall to 1000 metres then rise to 1500 metres later on Thursday.
