

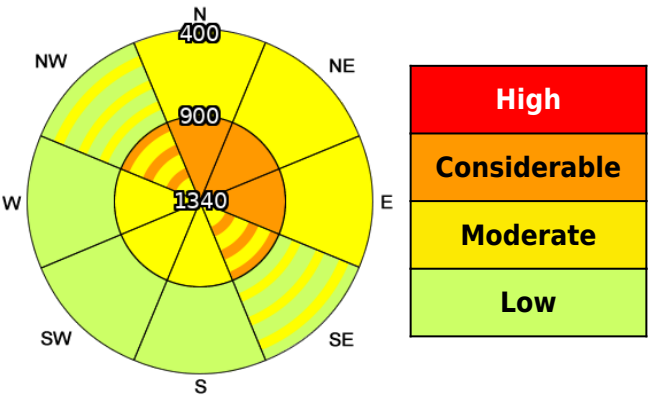

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 11/12/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Overnight and through the day unstable windslab will be deposited mainly on North to East aspects, and in other sheltered locations above 900 metres. During the day some areas of windslab may also accumulate at lower levels. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight precipitation will briefly fall as rain up to around 900 metres as a band of milder air crosses the area. During the day the freezing level is expected to be around 600 metres, with showers falling as snow above 400 metres. Moderate winds will be from the South-West.

Comments

No avalanche forecasts issued from tomorrow (Sunday 11th) until Wednesday 14th. Daily forecasts issued from Thursday the 15th onwards.
