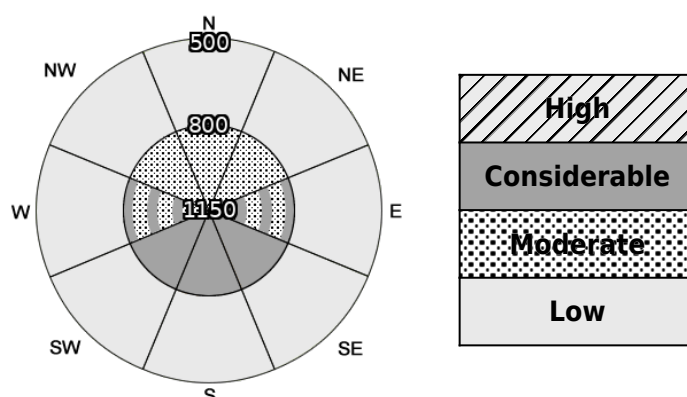


**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE****Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 17/12/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

New accumulations of unstable windslab will form in sheltered locations mainly on South-East to South-West aspects mainly above 800 metres. These new deposits will be weakly bonded especially on steeper slopes. The snowpack will remain moderately bonded on other slopes aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight , snow showers with moderate North-Westerly winds with a freezing level at 800 metres. During the day snow showers with stronger Northerly winds are expected with the freezing level at 600 metres. It should become drier towards the afternoon.

**Comments**

Localised, heavy snow showers are forecast during Friday night becoming less frequent during the day. Climbing conditions on ridges and buttresses are good as is the skiing at White Corries/ Glencoe Mountain.
